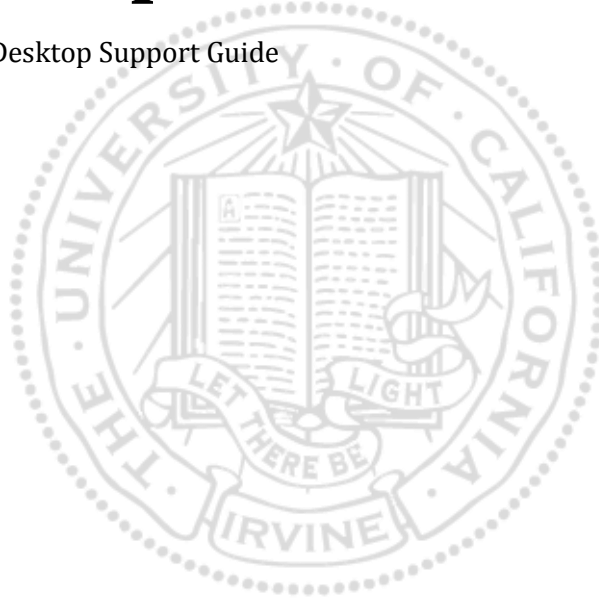


## Tiger Text Notifier – Desktop Client

Here we will cover where to download and how to install Tiger Text Notifier.

### Downloading Tiger Text Notifier

1. Navigate to <https://intranet.hs.uci.edu/Pages/sccm.aspx> and log in with your UCINetID Credentials if you are prompted.

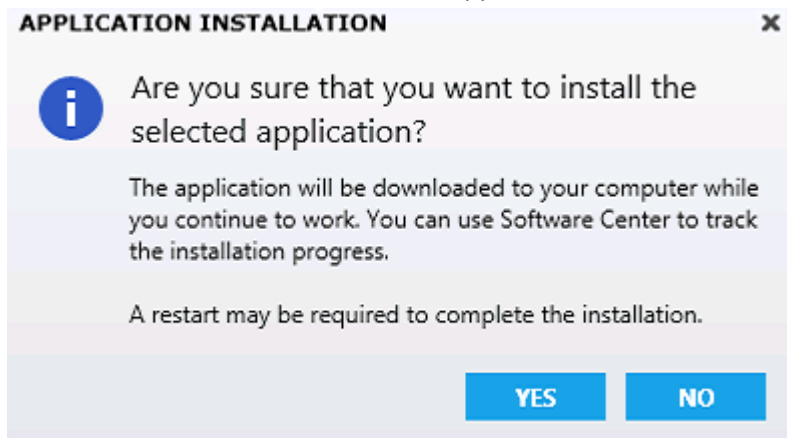
2. Click on **TigerText Notifier**.

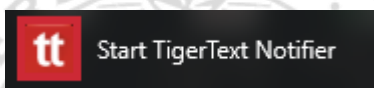
The application will install on your computer and you will be notified when the application installation finishes.

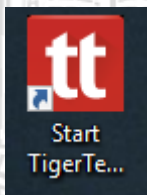
## How to Use Tiger Text Notifier

- Open Desktop Notifier
  - You can open the Desktop Notifier from two locations; The Windows Start Menu or the desktop shortcut.

i. Start Menu -



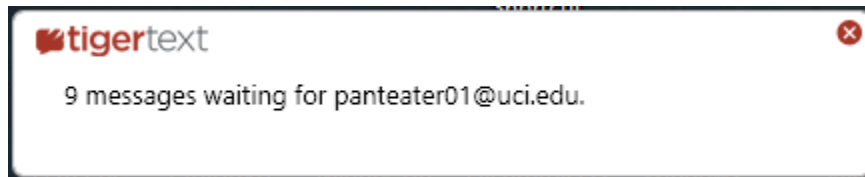
ii. Desktop Shortcut -



- Once the application has been installed, it will log you in automatically. You may be prompted to enter in your credentials.
